

Requirements for visiting PhD students at DPU

Agreements concerning visiting PhD students are contingent on the fulfilment of the following requirements:

- The PhD student must submit a written application presenting the scholarly reasons for the stay. This application must be approved by the host researcher at DPU.
- The visit must also be approved by the relevant head of department at DPU.
- The student must be affiliated with a tenured member of academic staff (the host researcher) at DPU, who ensures that the visiting student is aware of and included in relevant academic activities.
- The visiting PhD student's research must comply with EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), including the so-called *Private Shield Regulation* (which provides the framework regarding the types of data that may be transferred outside the EU and the procedures for such transfer).
- The visiting student's home university must approve the stay.
- As a rule, the stay should be for a period of no more than six months.
- The visiting student is expected to take part in scholarly activities at the department. This can involve anything from a presentation at a lunch meeting to assisting with peer review of colleagues' work.
- The visiting student covers all expenses related to the stay. (Payment may be waived at the school management's discretion).
